Subject: Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006: Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

According to article 33 of the REACH Regulation, Caleffi S.p.A. is required to inform the recipients of the complex articles/objects supplied about the presence of SVHC substances in concentrations higher than 0.1% weight/weight. These substances are included in the Candidate List defined by article 59 of the REACH Regulation.

From 5 January 2021, if a company produces, assembles, imports or distributes a complex article/object that contains SVHC substances present in the Candidate List in a concentration greater than 0.1% weight/weight of the article, it is also mandatory to include it in the SCIP database. The SCIP database was established by ECHA pursuant to Articles 9(1)(i) and 9(2) of Directive (EU) 2018/851, amending the Waste Directive (Directive 2008/98/EC).

To the best of our knowledge, at the date of issue of this declaration and based on the information requested and received from our raw material suppliers, the complex articles/objects supplied by Caleffi S.p.A. that contain SVHC substances have been registered in the SCIP database and the corresponding SCIP number is available. Complex articles/objects without a SCIP number do not contain any of the substances included in the Candidate list.

Under the terms of 1907/2006/CE Regulation, Caleffi S.p.A. is a manufacturer of products and acts as a downstream user of substances; no registration, pre-registration or authorization requirement is necessary for these substances. Caleffi S.p.A. requires its suppliers to periodically update information in accordance with the most recent changes and implementations of laws and regulations regarding declarations on materials.
